

Concentrated Hydrogen Peroxide is hazardous and highly corrosive if ingested or handled improperly. Concentrated hydrogen peroxide should only be used by properly trained professionals in an industrial or medical setting using appropriate personal protective equipment. While some high strength hydrogen peroxide is labelled as "Food Grade", this refers exclusively to food processing applications and is not suitable for direct human or animal consumption. Lower strength (3%) topical hydrogen peroxide and hydrogen peroxide-based consumer products including topical antiseptic solutions, mouthwash, and toothpastes can be hazardous if not used in accordance with their label instructions. Under no circumstance should hydrogen peroxide at any concentration be injected, inhaled, or directly ingested.
